Scholarship Application

2025 – Two \$1,000 Scholarship Awards

Teamsters Credit Union has established a scholarship for the education of students who are immediate family relatives of active Teamsters Credit Union members and are pursuing post-secondary studies.

Credit union membership is required for a Teamster member's family relative to be eligible to apply for this scholarship award. Credit union membership is exclusive for Teamsters and their families. *Scholarship applicants may also join Teamsters Credit Union to take advantage of the credit union savings, checking, and loan services.*

Applicants are limited to winning no more than two scholarship awards from Teamsters Credit Union.

The winner will be selected by lot and announced at Teamsters Credit Union's Annual Meeting.

The qualifying winner must claim scholarship awards no later than November 30 in the calendar year they are awarded – and will be disbursed no later than November 30 in the calendar year they are awarded.

Funds will be issued to the recipient's college, upon receipt of a current invoice, that includes the following information:

1. Recipient/Student Name and Student ID
2. College Name and Mailing Address – specific for scholarship awards

If the invoice total is less than \$1,000, an award of such a lesser amount may be made.
